Membership Committee Seeking Volunteers

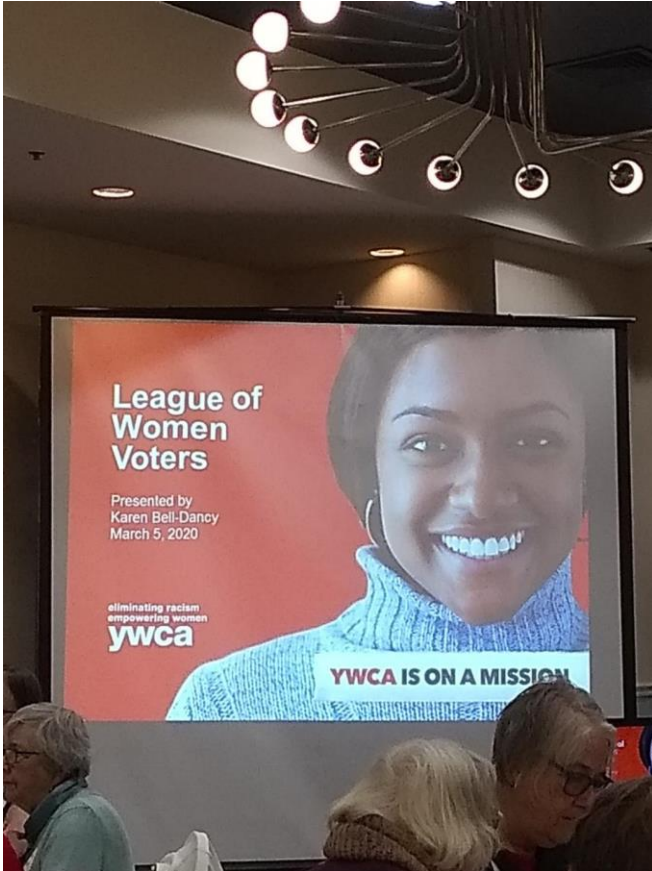

Voter Registration Volunteers Needed

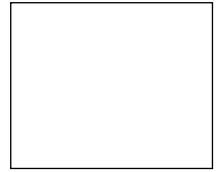
With the 2020 elections on the horizon, Lancaster County and the League of Women Voters-Lincoln/Lancaster County are in need of volunteer voter registrars. Prior to registering voters, a registrar must go through a short training session (approximately one hour); to schedule a session, contact Deputy Election Commissioner Maura Kelly at 402-441-6500. Training certificate must be renewed every three years.

YWCA Programs for Girls and Young Women Topic of March 5th Lunch & Learn

Karen Bell-Dancy, Executive Director of the Lincoln YWCA, spoke to the League of Women Voters Lunch & Learn on March 5th, 2020, about the program opportunities for girls and young women offered by the YWCA. Programs include the SMART Girls Club, which helps prepare girls for careers in STEM fields; Take a Break, which offers a break to parents of young children; the Circle of Security, a parenting program; Girls Circle, a program targeting middle school students; Job Outfitters, a program that helps needy people find clothing appropriate for their jobs; and Project Restore, an advocacy system for families facing Juvenile interventions.
