October Lunch & Learn: Growing Lincoln's Workforce

The popular Lunch & Learn Series continues on October 5 with three panelists speaking on "Growing Lincoln's Workforce." The panelists include Kelly Ross of the ECHO Collective, which empowers refugee and immigrant women through entrepreneurship and creative expression. Dylan Wren, Workforce Administrator for the American Job Center, which helps job seekers get back to work, find a better job, change careers, or enter the workforce for the first time. Bryan Seck is the executive director of Lincoln Literacy, which works to strengthen our community with language and literacy skills.

The event is Thursday, October 5, from noon to 1:00 PM and is free and open to the public throughout Nebraska via Zoom. Membership is not required.

LWV-LL Office has Moved

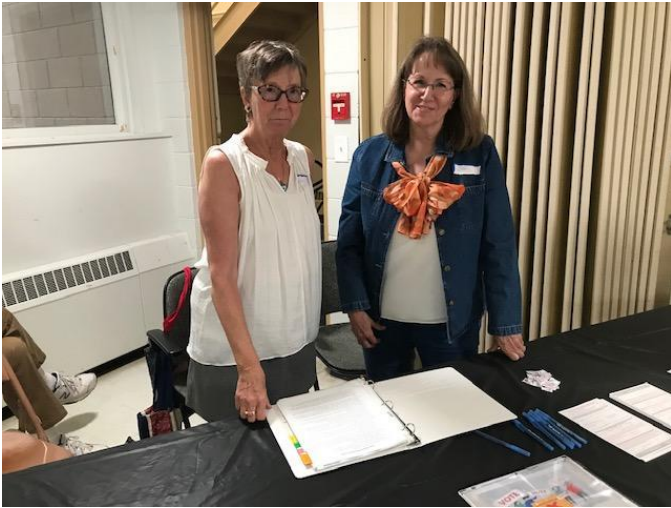

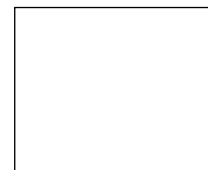


Voter Registrations at the Indian Health Center
